Driving Directions

Gatwick Airport is 5 miles from the hotel.

- From North Terminal continue forward onto Longbridge Gate.
- Bear right onto Departures Road then bear left onto Northway.
- At the Roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A23 sign posted South Terminal, Exit, M23.
- At the next roundabout take the 1st exit onto the M23 SPUR, sign posted Brighton.
- Leave the M23 at junction 10A and at the roundabout take the 3rd exit onto Balcombe Road B2036.

The Europa Gatwick Hotel can be found on the left-hand side.

Transportation to/from Airport/Train Station

The shuttle bus for the Gatwick Europa Hotel operates from Gatwick Airport every 45 minutes and leaves from the Courtesy Bus area at both the North and South Terminal.

The Gatwick Express train leaves London Victoria Station every 15 minutes during peak times. This is a non-stop train taking 30 minutes. Then catch the courtesy bus to the hotel.
