## The Labyrinth

Sexual addiction shatters the lives not only of addicts, but their partners and children as well. In fact, it impacts all the addict's relationships. The Labyrinth is an innovative and intensive treatment program for sexual addiction, designed to offer healing to the whole system without requiring that you leave your daily life for weeks or months at a time.

Our program follows a task centered approach developed by Patrick Carnes, PhD. It is rooted in the development of specific competencies that research has proven to be necessary for sustained recovery.

## Diversity

The Labyrinth values diversity. We welcome participants of any race, gender, religion, creed, age, sexual orientation or national origin.

## Structure

The Labyrinth is a 12 month program that includes:

- group therapy twice weekly.
- psychoeducational group weekly for ten weeks
- 12 step group meeting four times weekly

Treatment especially designed for the needs and experiences of family members of sexual addicts includes:

- Group therapy weekly
- Psychoeducational group weekly for ten weeks
- 12 step support group meetings twice weekly

Individual and couples therapy can be arranged as needed for an additional cost.

## Confidentiality

The Labyrinth follows HIPAA guidelines and regulations. We require that participants in the program agree to not discuss who attends our program or the content of group therapy.

## Cost

Treatment for sexual addiction can be expensive. These costs increase when other family members are involved. Inpatient programs can cost as high as \$1000 a day.

At The Labyrinth, the annual fee for the person struggling with sexual addiction is \$8,000. Treatment for the partner is an additional \$4,000. Payment plans are available upon request.

For those who desire to pay in full at the beginning of the program, these fees are discounted to \$7,500 and \$3,500 respectively.
